Renting of Mattresses and Umbrellas

The attention of the Authority has been drawn that some traders issued with licences by the Authority for renting of mattresses and umbrellas on public beaches are not complying to the criteria and conditions under which the licences were issued to them by: -

- i. Placing excess mattresses and umbrellas other than specified in their licences; and
- ii. Placing outright all mattresses and umbrellas over the whole stretch, thus, causing obstructions and inconvenience to the public frequenting public beaches.

Traders concerned are kindly requested to: -

- i. carry out their trading activities with only the authorised amount of mattresses and umbrellas as specified in their licence; and
- ii. allow free passage and no obstruction to be caused on the public beach.

The Authority is carrying out close monitoring of such activities.

Failure to comply with the conditions under which such licences have been issued will entail the revocation of their licences in accordance with the Regulations in force.
