COMMUNIQUE

Sanitary measures to be followed on resumption of activities on public beaches

General Guidelines to be followed by Beach Traders / Lessees of Tuck shops

- 1. In the event traders/lessees of tuck shops have body temperature above 37.8C or displaying symptoms of the COVID 19, they shall not operate
- 2. Daily disinfection of tuck shops/structures/vehicles prior to start of operations
- 3. Wearing of face masks at all times
- 4. Provision of hand sanitiser to clients
- 5. Discourage touching of items put on sales by clients and these items to be immediately disinfected if touched by clients
- 6. Garbage and food waste to be properly dumped in closed bins and disposed of in an appropriate manner

<u>Toilet Blocks on public beaches</u> Service providers to ensure

- 1. Frequently used facilities/amenities such as handles, handrails, switches, doorknobs to be disinfected regularly
- 2. To ensure the proper functioning of soap and disinfectant solution dispensers, disposable tissue dispensers, and other similar devices.
- 3. Defective units to be rapidly repaired and replaced
- 4. Regular pressure cleaning of toilet blocks.

Facilities and amenities on public beaches Service providers to ensure

- 1. Regular cleaning of amenities such as picnic tables, bins, kiosks etc.
- 2. Regular emptying of bins and carting away of wastes
